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Objectives and learning outcomes of the course

The goal of the course is not simply sharing information, but supporting participants in adapting the course content for their own educational system, curricula and everyday practices.

Participants will:

- understand the theoretical foundations of social and emotional learning (SEL) in educational contexts, with special focus on the Finnish education environment
- be able to apply strategies to foster students' positive behaviours and attitudes as SEL educators
- be able to facilitate positive peer relationships and collaborative learning experiences through implementing social learning principles in classroom management
- learn how to assess and evaluate the impact of social learning initiatives
- develop action plans for sustaining a culture of social learning in their school environments
- improve communication skills and soft skills in English and develop language for classroom use and planning
- develop their professional skills through interacting with colleagues of other nationalities, exchanging ideas, materials and experiences
- develop their international professional network which will enhance their motivation in teaching
